

Arnold Says:

Expenditures will exceed revenues by about \$6 billion.

Expenditures have exceeded revenues by billions for five years.

Revenues are expected to grow by \$5 billion to about \$85 billion.

Expenditures are expected to grow by \$9 billion to \$90 billion.

California owns 70,000 vehicles.

It can only find 40,000 vehicles.

California Debt (June 1, 2004)

	Outstanding	Unsold
General Obligation Bonds	\$33 billion	\$30 billion
Lease Revenue Bonds	\$7 billion	none
Deficit Reduction Bonds	\$11.3 billion	\$3.7 billion
Total	\$51.3 billion	\$33.7 billion

About 6.2% of the budget is debt service. Debt service will reach 7.5% in 2008-09




The Super Majority Requirement


California's Personal Income Tax




